310ft, 3,000 U.S.C.G. Certified Passenger Convention-Entertainment Vessel for Sale. Exclusively in our hands; this Vessel is turn key, ready for immediate operation and entertainment. All Current Certificates / Certificate of Inspection completed by the U.S.C.G. in July 2022. Vessel is reported to be in first class condition with lots of "wow" factor. Built in 1995, and then a full modern rebuild completed in 2019.

Stack Clearance / Air Draft of 80ft. There is a total of 47,863sqft of Public area, and 80,000 sq feet total. This vessel is a replica of the Historic "Robert E. Lee racing sidewheel steamboat" crafted nearly 130 years ago. Construction took 200 workers over 12 months to complete. The exterior was designed by RA Stern to appear as if the boat is straight from the Civil War Era. Interior Design by Morris & Brown Architects. Purely Las Vegas Glamour. The deckhouse is additionally fitted with two elevators port and starboard (port is dedicated as a freight elevator, and starboard is dedicated as a passenger elevator).

The main deck is outfit with a food prep area to port midship. The food prep area is fitted with an industrial dishwasher. The main deck area is fitted with three each starboard, and two each port. Below deck accesses and the port service elevator descends to the below deck storage area. Port midship is fitted with a food prep area with five industrial food warming storage units, two each 2-door coolers, and one each 3-door cooler, two stainless steel sinks, and one each 7'x 2' stainless steel prepping tables.

Has flanking rudders. Port & Starboard bridge wing consoles. Has CO2 suppression system with 45-second delay, and three 5' bottles. Many new upgrades to all onboard systems completed with USCG approvals,

Approximate hours on machinery - Port main engine: 11,328 - Starboard main engine: 11,384 - Bow thruster: 8,208 - Generator No. 1, port: 4,925 - Generator No. 2, center: 28,460 - Generator No. 3, starboard: 4,803 - Emergency generator: 896. Vessel has a 2021 survey with a valuation of fair market value at \$31,000,000.00.
